

## Transcript: accessing e-books

The Library subscribes to thousands of e-books across a number of publisher platforms.

Some of these e-books will be included in your reading lists, but for many of them, you will need to search in the library catalogue.

If you know the title or author, enter these in the search box to see if an e-book is available.

Another way to find them is to browse e-books on a particular topic. Enter a search term, for example 'fashion'.

You can then use the menu on the left hand side to refine by Source Type.

To find e-books in the list, click 'More'.

Next select e-books – this will show you all the e-books we have on a particular topic.

You can then click on a title that you're interested in reading.

You will see more information about your title, and a link which will direct you to the e-book platform.

If you are not on a GSA networked computer, then you will be asked to log in using your GSA username and password.

Depending on the publisher, you have options to read online, download the whole book, or download individual chapters. The amount you can print, copy or save from a book will vary.
