Transcript: Finding and accessing e-journals

The Library carries magazines and journals in print and digital format and you can find these by searching the library catalogue.

If you know the name of the journal you're looking for, enter this in the search box and select the correct record.

For example, a search for 'Vogue' will show you if we have print or online copies of the journal, or in some cases such as this a mix of both.

Under 'Print Holdings' you will see what issues and years are available and where there are any gaps in our collection

The link above indicates that we also provide online access, and which year we have access to.

There may be more than one link available, so select the most appropriate one for the dates you want.

Online access to different journals is provided by a variety of publisher platforms, and you maybe be required to login using your GSA username and password. Some, like Vogue, are available on our e-magazine app Flipster.

On in Flipster, search for Vogue again or browse other magazines on offer in the app. You will be taken to the most recent issue so to see past issues select 'All Issues' on the right hand side.

You can also browse e-journals on your topic using the Subject Guides.

Choose your Subject Guide and then go to 'Browse Journals and Magazines' where you'll find a list of links to the most relevant journals in your subject. Select a link to go through to the catalogue entry for this journal. Any questions, contact the Library for help.
